"Through our Eyes is an event that reflects on what the First Nations people of the East Cost of Australia would have seen and felt of the "strange thing sailing by - have you ever wondered?"

The written account during the journey of Captain James Cook as he travelled along the coast on the Endeavour recorded sightings and fires as he sailed from Botany Bay (Kamay) to Possession Island in the Torres Straits.
